

Kids Ride Free program – **IMPORTANT UPDATE**

As of **August 1, 2017**, kids 5 to 12 years of age will no longer be permitted to ride free without their own key fobs. (kids 4 years and under do not require a fob for their ride)

Kids riding LTC are required to tap their LTC key fob on the smart card reader to record their ride. This is required so we can count the actual rides being provided.

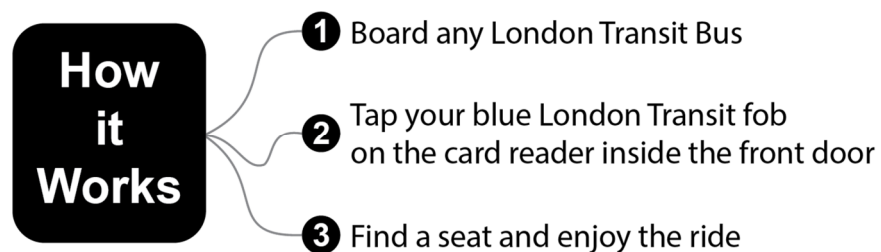
We have chosen to issue a fob versus a smart card given it can be easily attached to a zipper, backpack, or lanyard, making it easy for your child to keep track of. We suggest you obtain a separate fob for each of your children that will be riding LTC.

The fobs are available at our two locations (450 Highbury Ave or Dundas/Richmond). Staff will also be on hand at the following locations and times for the distribution of the fobs.
